USPG Harvest Appeal 2017 – this year the USPG Harvest Appeal focusses on the effects of climate change, particularly in Madagascar.

What would you do if there wasn't going to be a harvest? This is the dilemma facing communities in Madagascar. Drought and torrential rains have washed away farmland and depleted nutrients in the soil. This means the land can no longer yield a healthy harvest. At the same time in coastal regions, rising sea temperatures have reduced fish stocks, so fishermen must venture out into deeper and more dangerous waters. The church is responding with emergency aid with training in preparation for future disasters. And in helping communities generate an income – so they can buy food. This harvest, find out more and support work that is saving lives.
